Note:

1. Payment Terms:

- For the first year, the registration and programme fees must be paid as specified in the Provisional Admission offer letter.
- For subsequent years, starting from the second year, the annual programme fee remains unchanged and is due for payment on or before May 15th every year.
- Programme Fees remain applicable per annum till the submission of the Thesis.
- Additional fees*, any incidental and student club membership charges will be applicable and must be paid based on the notification as and when announced.
- Candidates who want to remit the fees in foreign currency can do so by remitting the foreign currency equivalent to INR based on the exchange rate then prevailing.

2. Duration:

- The Duration of the Ph.D. programme shall be a minimum of three years and a maximum of six years including the course work.
- A maximum of an additional two years can be given through a process of re-registration as per the Statutes/Ordinance of the University. Provided, however, the total period should not exceed eight years from the date of admission to the Ph.D. programme.
- Provided further that, female Ph.D. scholars and Persons with Disabilities (having more than the benchmark disability of 40%) may be allowed an additional relaxation of two (2) years; however, the total period for completion of a Ph.D., programme in such cases should not exceed ten years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. programme. Women research scholars may be granted maternity leave/ childcare leave of 240 days, once in the entire duration of the research programme.
