Objective:

To acknowledge the exceptional academic achievements of students in the Batch, categorized by their respective programs and specializations.

Background of the Policy

The recognition of top-performing individuals will be based on the following criteria:

The Office of the Examination and Evaluation will compile a merit list for each program, batch wise/area wise, of the final-year students. This merit list will be announced at the Convocation Ceremony. Based on this merit list, gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the top three students in each program and batch.

For programs that offer multiple specializations, each consisting of a minimum of 24 credits in specialization courses, a medal will be awarded to the top-performing student in each specialization.

Merit List Preparation Criteria

1. Eligibility Restrictions:

- Students who have successfully passed all courses on their first attempt without any discontinuity will be eligible for inclusion on the merit list.
- Students who have transferred from other universities are not eligible for the merit list and hence for Rank.
- Students who are found guilty of misconduct in disciplinary proceedings or subject to disciplinary action during their program will not be eligible for consideration of the merit list.
- Students who are found to have engaged in malpractice will not be eligible for inclusion in the merit list.






2. Determination of Rank Holders:

- Rank holders are determined based on their CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average).
- In cases where two students have the same CGPA, the CWPM (Cumulative Weighted Percentage Marks) will be used to identify the topper.
- If the tie persists, the CGPA will be evaluated with additional decimal places until a topper is determined.
- If the tie remains unresolved, both students will be awarded the same rank.

3. Recognition for Lateral Entry Students:

- B.Tech lateral entry students who joined in Semester III after completing their diploma will be eligible for a separate lateral entry rank medal.
- This medal will be awarded to the top performer among the lateral entry cohort (all branches put together), with CGPA calculated from Semester III onwards.
